Slovenian Business and Research Association invites you to the national information day for Slovenian stakeholders to present the 2022 calls for proposals, published recently by the Clean Hydrogen Partnership. 300.5 million EUR will be available to support projects that boost renewable hydrogen production, reduce its costs, develop its storage and distribution solutions, and stimulate the use of low carbon hydrogen in hard to abate sectors, such as energy intensive industries, aviation or heavy duty transport. The call will also continue to help stimulating the deployment of “hydrogen valleys” across Europe, complex projects that cover the entire hydrogen value chain in a specific region, scaling-up hydrogen deployment and creating interconnected hydrogen ecosystems across Europe.
