Tamás Kozsik is associate professor at the Faculty of Informatics of Eötvös Loránd University (Budapest, Hungary), where he also serves as vice-dean responsible for academic affairs and innovation. He is teaching and researching programming languages, software technology, as well as concurrent, parallel, and distributed programming. Recently attention has turned towards quantum computing. He was PI in the EU-funded ParaPhrase project, and coordinator of several national projects. Currently he is PI in the Quantum Information National Laboratory of Hungary.
